Monya Rowe Gallery is pleased to announce the summer group exhibition titled *Looking In, Looking Out* featuring Larissa Bates, Lacey Black, Aubrey Levinthal, Erin Milez, Carson Monahan, Kathy Osborn, Marcelle Reinecke, Bryan Rogers, Calli Ryan, Gretchen Scherer and Lily Gibbs Taylor. The opening reception for the artists will be held on Thursday, June 19, 6-8 PM.

Looking In, Looking Out brings together a group of artists investigating the boundaries between public and private spaces. From common places such as airplanes and cafes to the pathway windows create to private lives. Within artworks, windows can act as a framing device highlighting psychological tension. The title of the exhibition doubles as a metaphor for looking inward and alludes to the act of being perceived and perceiving. The works on view convey passivity, voyeurism, discomfort, desire and heightened self-awareness, sometimes simultaneously.

Larissa Bates (b. 1981, Burlington, VT) was raised between Vermont and Vara Blanca, Costa Rica. She received a BA from *Hampshire College*, MA. Recent exhibitions include *Taymour Grahne*, London, *Myriam Chair Galerie*, Paris; and *Monya Rowe Gallery*, NY. In 2024, her work was included in the group exhibition "Gilded: Contemporary Artists Explore Value and Worth" at the *Weatherspoon Art Museum*, Greensboro, NC, which traveled to the *Hunter Museum of American Art*, Chattanooga, TN and the *Hood Museum of Art*, Dartmouth, Hanover, NH. Bates' work is in the permanent collection of the *Hood Museum of Art*. The artist lives and works in Dobbs Ferry, NY.

Lacey Black (b. 1992, Pittsburgh, PA) received an MFA from *Purchase College State University of New York*, Harrison, NY and a BA from *Rhode Island School of Design*, Providence, RI. Recent exhibitions include *PS122 Gallery*, NY, *Richard and Doll Maas Gallery*, Purchase, NY; and *Monya Rowe Gallery*, NY. The artist lives and works in Mt. Vernon, NY.

Aubrey Levinthal (b. 1986, Philadelphia, PA) received a MFA from the *Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts* (*PAFA*), Philadelphia, PA and a BA from *The Pennsylvania State University*, University Park, PA. She is a threetime recipient of an *Elizabeth Greenshields Foundation Grant* and in 2017 was awarded a residency at *Ballinglen Arts Foundation*, North County Mayo, Republic of Ireland. Recent exhibitions include *Haverkampf Galerie*, Berlin; *Ingleby Gallery*, Edinburgh, Scotland; M + B, Los Angeles; and Monya *Rowe Gallery*, NY. In 2022 Levinthal's work was included in the group exhibition "A Place for Me: Figurative Painting Now" at *The Institute of Contemporary Art (ICA*), Boston, where her work is now part of the permanent collection. The artist lives and works in Philadelphia, PA. **Carson Monahan** (b. 1985, Ann Arbor, MI) received a BBA from *Eastern Michigan University*, Ypsilanti, Michigan. Recent exhibitions include *Conduit Gallery*, Dallas, TX; *Monument*, Kingston, NY; and *Monya Rowe Gallery*, NY. In 2023, the artist was awarded a residency at *Willow House*, Terlingua, Texas. Monahan is a self-taught artist who lives and works in Detroit, MI.

Erin Milez (b. 1994, Pittsburgh, PA) received a MFA from *New York Academy of Art*, NY and a BA from *Seattle Pacific University*, Seattle, WA.
